After the initial success of its first liner, SS Great Western of 1838, the Great Western Steamship Company collected materials for a sister ship, tentatively named City of New York. The same engineering team that had collaborated so successfully on Great Western—Isambard Brunel, Thomas Guppy, Christopher Claxton and William Patterson—was again assembled.

The Planter sailed from London April 2 or 11, 1635, arriving at Boston June 7, 1635. n.b. Hotten has Trance, Nico for the master. This information was transcribed in the 19th century by James Savage, and later by Michael Tepper from records found in the Public Rolls Office, London. For each common date of record, groupings of persons in consecutive order in the roll often indicate some relation by kinship, household or town origin.

arrived at Melbourne August 12th, sailed 19th and arrived at Sydney 22nd August 1854 Melbourne : — The Lady Jocelyn (ship picture) came up the Bay in the forenoon of Saturday. She sailed from Southampton on the 4th June, at 4pm., and arrived at St. Vincent on the 16th at 6.40am., and sailed on the following morning at half-past ten.

Passenger Lists - Australia 1845-1854

The GREAT TASMANIA was a 1,964 ton wooden ship, length 203ft x beam 42.3ft, built in 1855 by D. McKay, Boston, Mass for the Black Ball Line. She was not used consistently on the Liverpool - Melbourne service but was sometimes routed to Hobart and Sydney and in 1860 sailed to Melbourne and Hobart.On the last occasion, she made the passage from Liverpool in 102 days.

The Winthrop Fleet was a group of 11 ships led by John Winthrop out of a total of 16 funded by the Massachusetts Bay Company which together carried between 700 and 1,000 Puritans plus livestock and provisions from England to New England over the summer of 1630, during the first period of the Great Migration.
