When you check the transmission fluid prior to changing it, make sure the engine is turned on. If you find that your transmission fluid level is lower than it should be, then you first need to make sure there are no leaks in the system. Once you can confirm that, replace the existing fluid right away with an adequate level of new fluid. Lastly, you can easily tell if the existing transmission fluid is bad because it will look rather brownish and may even have a bad burning odor to it.

Manual: Most manufacturers recommend that manual transmission fluid be changed every 30,000 to 60,000 miles. Under heavy-duty use, some manufacturers suggest changing transmission fluid every 15,000 miles.

In order to change transmission liquid in the gearbox, you need the following tool: a socket wrench 13, screwdriver T25, a cap wrench 17, a high nut (25–30mm) for a wrench 17, a container for collecting oil and special syringe for pouring oil in gearbox. This syringe can be uses for self-refilling transmission fluid of gearbox.

With the vehicle level, bring the transmission fluid temperature to warm between 35°C - 45°C (95°F – 113°F). At this temperature range, you can remove the transmission drain plug and transmission fluid should begin to flow out from the fill port level insert. When this happens, the proper DSG fluid level has beeing achieved.

First check your owner's manual to make sure you know whether a flush or change of transmission fluid is typically recommended for your vehicle. When changing your transmission fluid, you open the transmission drain located on the underside of the car. This allows about 40% to 50% of the transmission fluid to drain out into the pan.
