TENS Units for Neck Pain: TENS units are not recommended to be used on the neck because of the sensitivity of that area. However, NHS has recommended using TENS units on the neck with the right placement. We recommend placing electrodes right below your neck, on the upper back. The electrical impulses will travel to the neck for neck pain relief.
