Carlucci describes Gramsci, using his own words (from Prison Notebooks) about Marx: a personality "in whom theoretical and practical activity are indissolubly intertwined" (21), he also stresses the philosopher's approach to translation (in the sense of "cultural translation"), and his conscious choice of words (such as Sardinian comune).
