One to one correspondence is an early, but simple form of math that a toddler learns as early as 2 years of age. When they begin to recognize, match, and count objects, they are learning one to one correspondence. Simply put, they are counting sets of matching elements.

One-to-One Correspondence Activities for Preschool. One-to-One correspondence is an important beginning math skill for preschoolers. It can take months, or even an entire year for preschoolers to begin counting objects with one-to-one correspondence. For this reason, it's important to provide young children with plenty of opportunities to practice counting one-to-one all year long in your preschool classroom.

I made this for children in a KS1 class. Most of the children are non-verbal and working within P2(ii)/P3. I would do lots of practical activities first for example getting children to place 6 marbles in an egg box. This could also be used as a TEACCH task if laminated and velcro stuck to each spider and web (our topic is ground, air, water.)

One-to-one correspondence is an early math concept that we, as adults, tend to take for granted. This developmental skill involves counting each object in a set once, and only once with one touch per object.

One-to-one correspondence is often difficult for young children to comprehend. In Maths recognising the number "ten," and being able to count out "ten" items are two separate skills. Linking objects with numbers enables a child to count with understanding (McCarthy, 2009). Common errors when counting a set of items can be:
