Characteristics of 20th Century Music. One of the most important developments in 20 th Century classical music was the effective dissolving of tonality. The entire system of keys that had dominated the musical landscape since the late Renaissance was by many composers, ultimately dismissed in favor of what would become known as 'serialism'. In the early part of the 20 th Century, Austrian born composer Arnold Schoenberg found that he had reached a harmonic impasse, and he needed a solution.
